When you and I spoke, you said to expect a letter from land use suggesting a meeting to review technical concerns about the Delsea monitoring application. What I received instead is a letter from Scott reiterating the position Tom Micai took at the first meeting, i.e. that DEP has sufficient data to declare the Delaware Bay off limits to wind, with an attached abstract from Kathy Clark et al.

Did I misunderstand, or has the Department's position changed from what you described? Is this a denial of the permit application, or is a separate decision document forthcoming? Is it really the Department's view that private parties will not have the opportunity to collect data that might modify, rebut, or qualify F&W's broad conclusions about the entire Bay?

I don't want to protract a debate or impose unduly on your time, but the letter is quite different from what I expected based on our conversation. Let me know or feel free to have Scott get back to me. Mostly I need to know if this is the denial or another document is expected.
