I've talked to both John and Greg, and everyone is on the same page – they've had these cameras onboard for years and there's still no clear path to implementation, despite the fact that they've been calling for one since the start.

Fishermen and staff are <u>extremely discouraged</u> with the lack of progress made towards implementation. And John Bullard's recent decision, while addressing imminent costs, comes at the expense of the only clear way to monitor this fishery accurately and cost-effectively into the future.

Until we see a detailed roadmap to implementation, a meeting here tomorrow is unnecessary and has been cancelled. We can discuss a planning meeting here in Chatham in the future if and when the industry sees a commitment to implementation.
