§ 1061.01. Establishment

(a) **IN GENERAL.**—The tract of land described as follows is reserved and withdrawn from settlement, occupancy, or sale under the laws of the United States and dedicated and set apart as a public park or pleasuring ground for the benefit and enjoyment of the people and is designated Yellowstone National Park (in this chapter referred to as the “Park”):

The tract of land in the States of Montana and Wyoming, lying near the headwaters of the Yellowstone River and described as follows: Commencing at the junction of Gardiner’s River, with the Yellowstone River, and running east to the meridian passing 10 miles to the eastward of the most eastern point of Yellowstone Lake; thence south along said meridian to the parallel of latitude passing 10 miles south of the most southern point of Yellowstone Lake; thence west along said parallel to the meridian passing 15 miles west of the most western point of Madison Lake; thence north along said meridian to the latitude of the junction of the Yellowstone River and Gardiner’s River; thence east to the place of beginning.

(b) **TRESPASSERS.**—A person that locates or settles on or occupies any part of the Park, except as provided in section 1061.06 of this title, shall be considered a trespasser and removed from the Park.
