

I or intermittent streams: seasonal streams that flow during certain times of the year when groundwater provides water for stream flow, and when precipitation supplements flow.

E or ephemeral streams: streams that flow only after precipitation; runoff from rainfall is the primary source of water for these streams.

H or headwater streams: the uppermost streams in the river network; those streams farthest from the river's endpoint or confluence with another stream. Headwater streams can be intermittent or ephemeral.

Population dependent: number of people dependent on intermittent, ephemeral or headwater streams in the county or state

SPA: Source Protection Area (the area upstream from a drinking water supply that provides water to the drinking water system)

Total population served: number of people served by public drinking water systems in the county or state
