Destruction of Public Records	ORC ANN. § 149.381 prohibits the destruction or damage of records. All records are the property of the public office concerned and shall not be removed, destroyed, mutilated, transferred, or otherwise damaged or disposed of, in whole or in part, except as provided by law.
