From: Sent: Sunday, April 16, 2017 4:34 PM Subject: Re: Interior Secretary Zinke is visiting SCI on Monday and bringing two fishermen with him - do you know them? I know both of them. Jeff Maassen is a good guy and I've had positive interactions with him on multiple occasions. He is one of the most educated fishermen in the area. He used to be pretty active but 7 years ago got frustrated with "the system" and left fishing. Recently he came back to urchin diving and is starting to get a little more involved. He's definitely supportive of good management but is a bit skeptical of NGOs and academics (although nothing close to Jason). You will likely find an ally in him - at least on some levels. I've only met Jason Robinson and his brother Shane once and they are possibly the most anti- Conservation fishermen I know. they are strongly opposed to any NGO interventions and from what I've heard - are anti government in general. They are opposed to science because they assume it is all towards increased regulation. They think groundfish fishery through our involvement. Frankly, I'm surprised he will be joining the trip.
